- Highlighting
- Enhance Datasheet Forms
- Enhance Continuous Forms
- Other / Miscellaneous

# Add Highlighting

- current control
- selected control or column
- sorted & filtered columns
- current record
- entire form (dim background)
- required fields
- search results

# Enhance Datasheet Forms

## Add buttons / search etc

- as subform
- as split form (single form hidden)

## Add security

- protect data
- lock down database objects



# Enhance Continuous Forms


- selectively hide controls (Paint Me Transparent)
- add multiselect filter
- hide and restore columns
- freeze columns
- move and resize columns
- hide duplicate values in a column

# Other / miscellaneous form features

- click me and I disappear
- dictation
- move and resize borderless form
- rounded corners
- gradient background fill
- stop forms opening from navigation pane
- animation, transparency & fade
- scrolling / flashing text
- control help text
- progress bar
